The Minister of Culture Nauris Puntulis has addressed the Mayor of Zedelgem Annika Vermelen with a call to resolve the issue of the monument "Latvia's hive for freedom" only through bilateral negotiations and respecting the agreement concluded between the municipality and the museum.
